Close call on pig numbers

THE tight seasonal conditions also took a toll on pig numbers at Midland last week casting further doubt on Primaries ability to conduct fortnightly markets.

Primaries' auctioneer Keith Taylor said Wednesday's yarding barely reached the minimum threshold of 200.

"However values at the sale were excellent and we are hoping that producers will be able to lift the offering to take advantage of the firm prices tipped to occur up to Christmas," Keith said.

He urged producers to nominate pigs early for the next scheduled Primaries sale on Wednesday, September 13.
