- No use of any synthetic pyrethroids (group A), diflubenzuron (group B) or triflumuron (Group C) at or since the previous shearing (including off shears back liners).
- No shower or plunge dipping of any sheep more than 6 weeks after the previous shearing.
- No use of organophosphates (group D) in the last 7 months before this shearing.
- No use of any other pesticide (group E) except extinosad (group F), in the last 2 months before this shearing.

## Explanatory Notes

Random testing of the pesticide status will be carried out to ensure that declarations are correct. It is an offence under the Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals (Control of Use) Act 1995 to make a false or misleading declaration. The maximum penalty is a fine of \$10,000.

If this is the first time you have shorn the sheep since you became responsible for their husbandry, either obtain a similar declaration from the previous person in charge, regarding the treatment history of the sheep, or do not use this declaration.

All products should be applied only as directed on the label.

Take special note of **individually treated sheep**. It is recommended that wool from struck sheep should be sold separately from untreated lines of wool.
